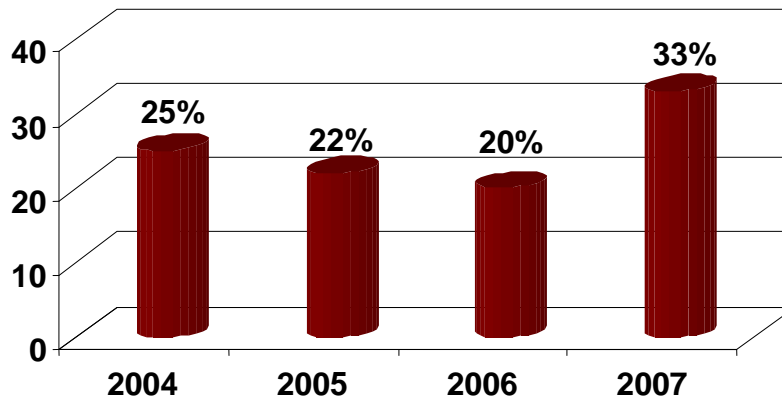


# The Global Corruption Barometer: The evolution of Romania in the period 2004-2007

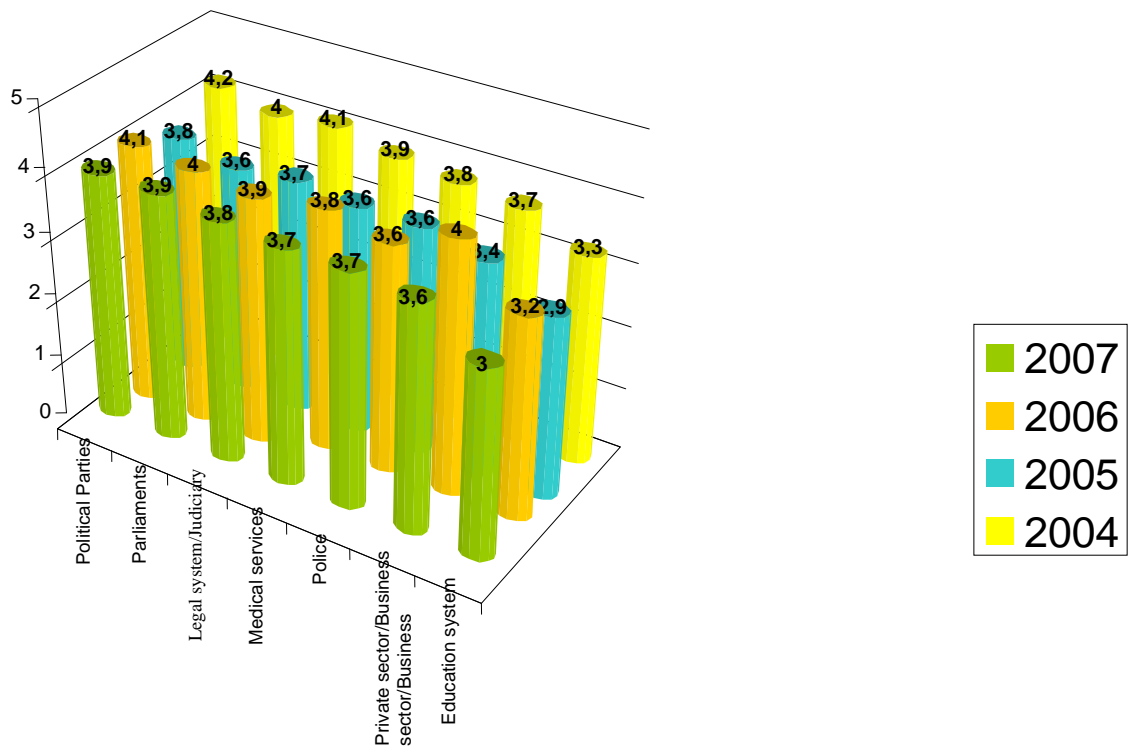
*In the past 12 months, have you or anyone living in your household paid a bribe in any form?*

in percentages of bribe payers**



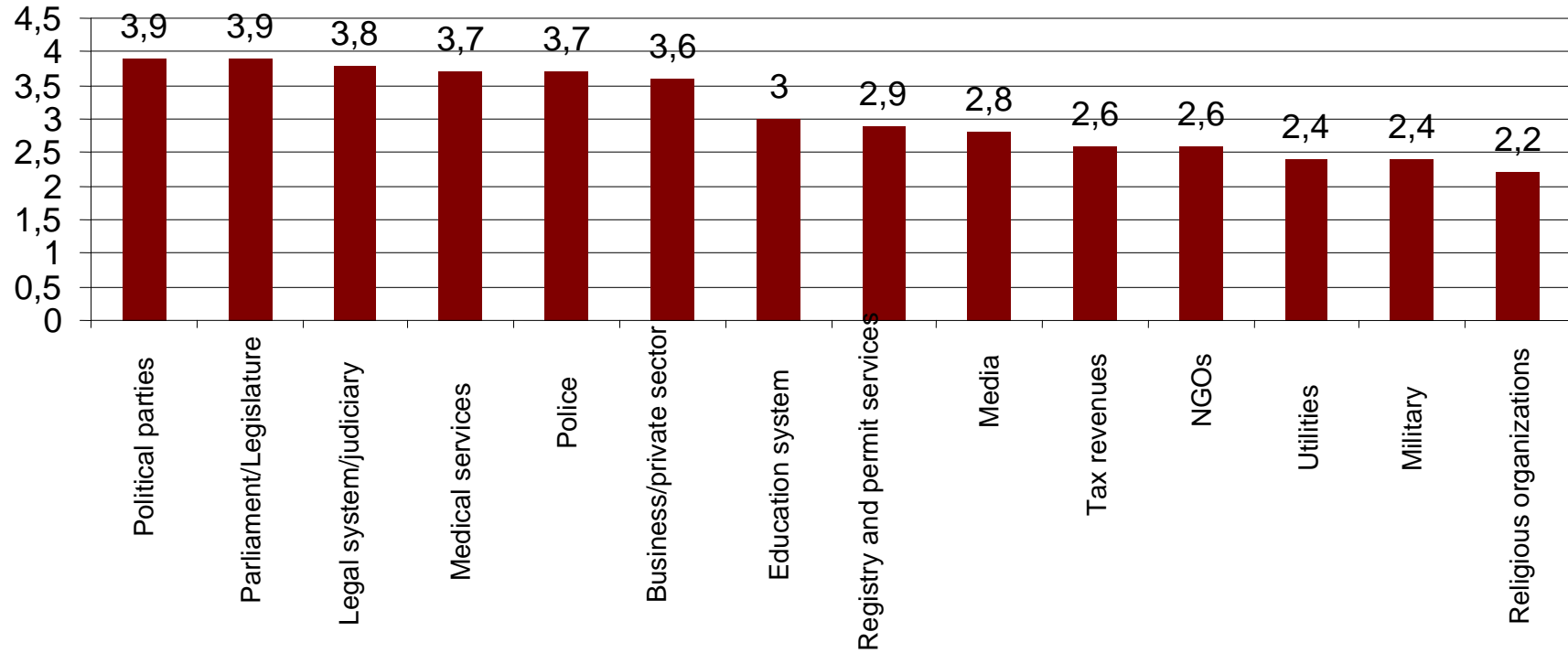
*To what extent do you perceive the following category in this country to be affected by corruption?*

## The most corrupt institutions in the period 2004-2007



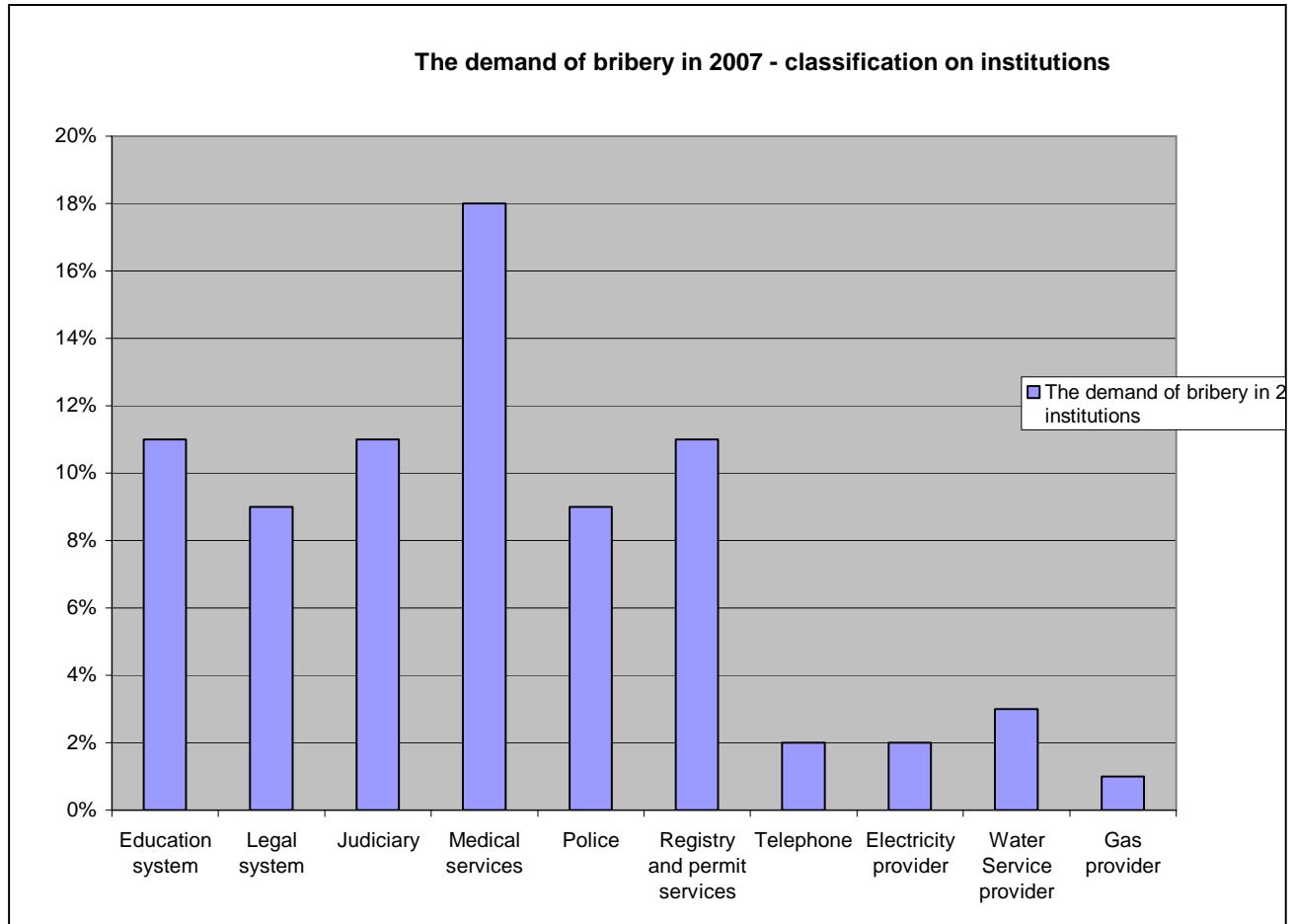

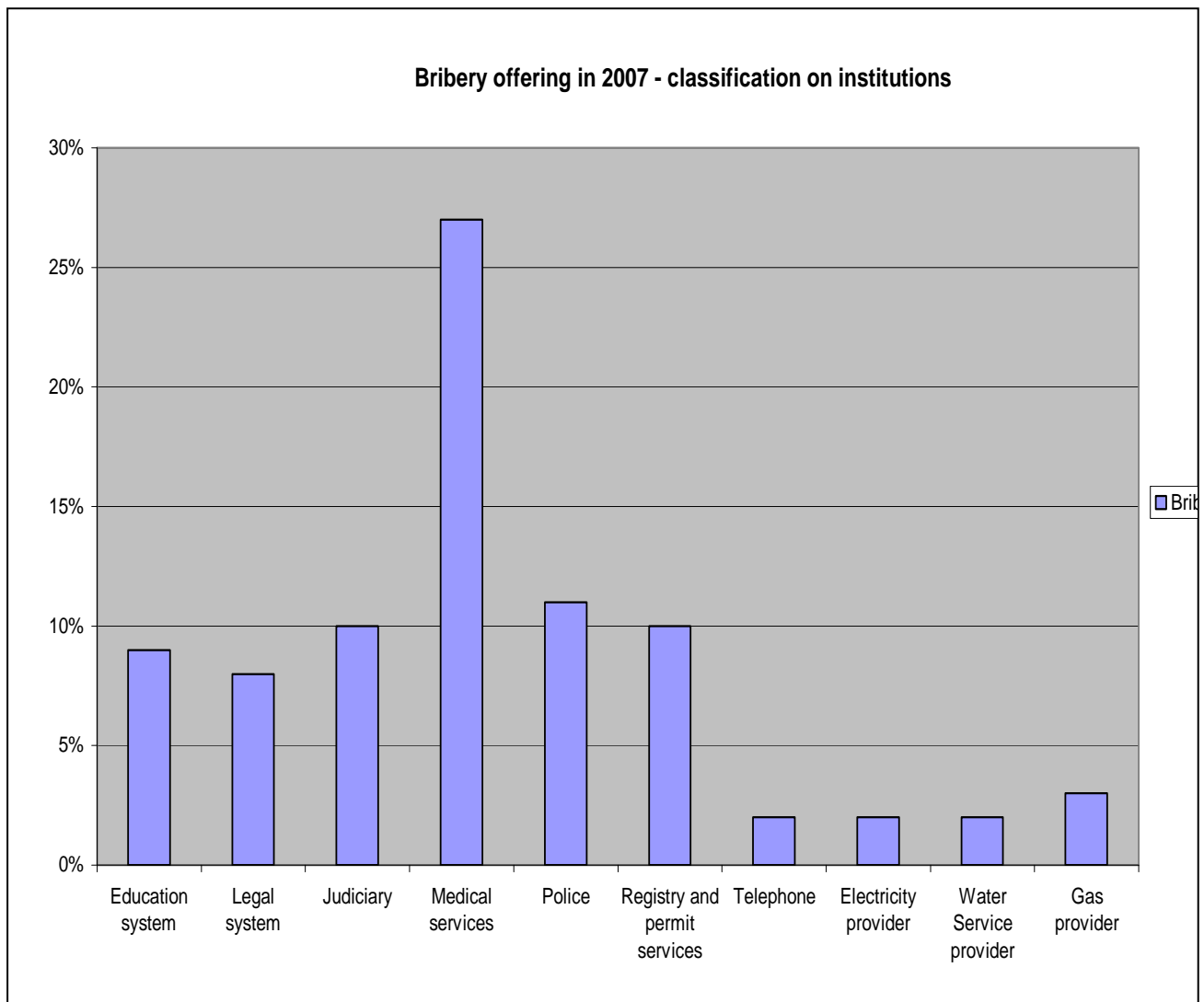

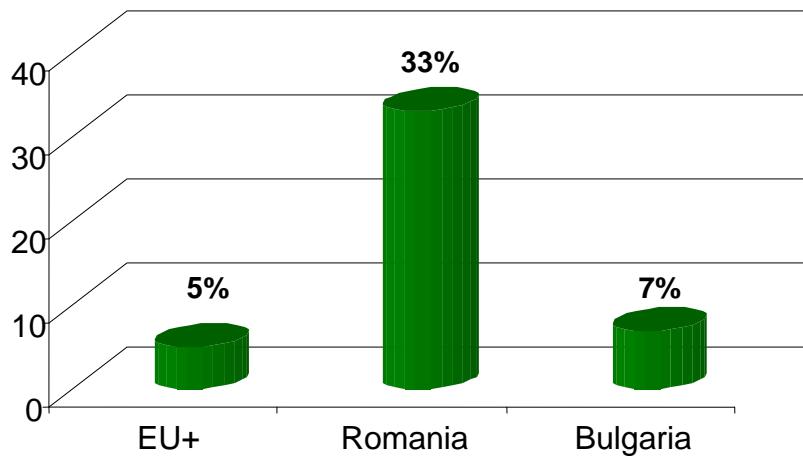
