ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE, TRANSPORTATION

Upon arrival you will be met at the airport by a driver holding a sign with your name on it. You will then be driven to the hotel, where you will be greeted by a TI/Romania representative who will answer any of your questions and who will provide you with more information if necessary.

Upon departure the hotel receptionist will call you one and a half hour prior to the time of departure from the hotel, and ten minutes before the car that will pick you up arrives. You will also be able to check the schedule at any time by asking for information from the hotel receptionists.

From the hotel to the Palace of the Parliament and backwards, the conference location, car transportation will be available for all participants.

DISTRIBUTION OF MATERIALS

The paper cases containing the materials for the conference (e.g. the RCC Report, Agenda) as well as the badges, will be given to you during the registration, which will take place at the beginning of the first day of the conference at the venue location.

ACCESS IN THE PARLIAMENT BUILDING

For security reasons, you will be asked to present an ID document (e.g., your passport) when entering the Parliament building. Please take into consideration that there will be metal detectors, so try carrying as few metal objects as possible in order to make the security procedures as fast and as easy as possible.

ATMS AND BANKS

The simplest and most cost effective means of obtaining currency in Bucharest is to withdraw Romanian Lei (RON) from a cash point machine (ATM). They accept debit and credit cards backed by Visa, MasterCard/Euro Card, Maestro and American Express.

Romanian word for ATM is "Bancomat" and for Bank is "Banca". On the same street as your Hotel, called Calea Victoriei, there are several very handy ATMs.

Banks and exchange offices are also a handy manner to obtain local currency.

CLIMATE

Average temperature in May is around 25°C, in the night it will decrease around 18° C.

Voltage is 220 V, European standard.
